



Inheriting a rundown estate in England, and having little money, Isabella and Charlie gambled everything on a new concept, "re-wilding." They simply guided their 1,400 acres to go back to nature. To bring back life to the hard-packed, barren soil ruined by centuries of overfarming, the couple introduces wild ponies from nearby Dartmoor, let deer wander, and allow herds of pigs to root, break up the soil and roam free. Now cows, sheep and pigs live and breed outdoors year round with little husbandry — or overhead.
